| Maps | If the trip is totally in the UK then Ordnance Survey Maps are the best. Also a Multi-Map or Google directions printout is handy for the initial route. For overseas travel this would also include maps local to the destination | |
| Guide Books | Always useful to get the most out of the trip | |
| Digital Camera Charger Memory Card | Great for recording the trip | |
| Digital Camcorder Charger Memory Card | Even better for getting those interesting action shots | |
| Paracetamol Ibuprofen Alka-Seltzer | Just in case we over do things | |
| Driving Licences | Although not essential in the UK, it is a must for overseas if any car driving is involved | |
| Tickets | Airline, Ferry, theatre etc. In these days of ticket less travel a printout of e-mail confirmation etc. is a good idea | |
